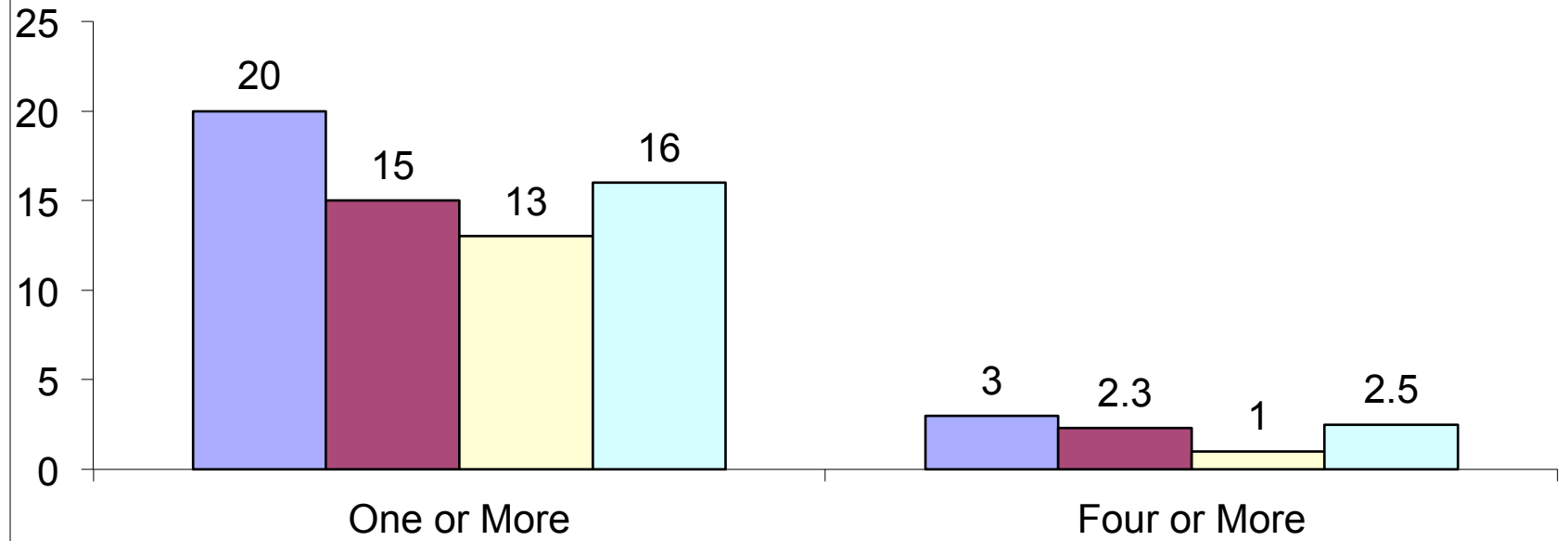

The Sample:

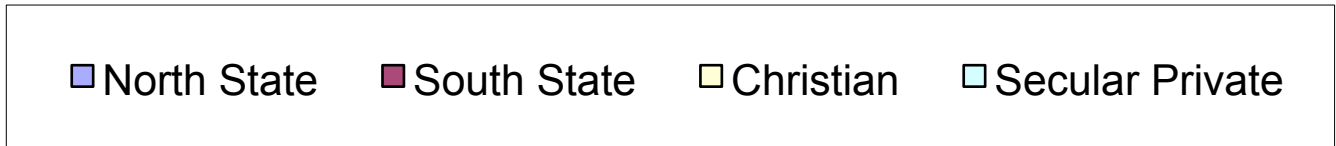
- North State College Students. n=1134

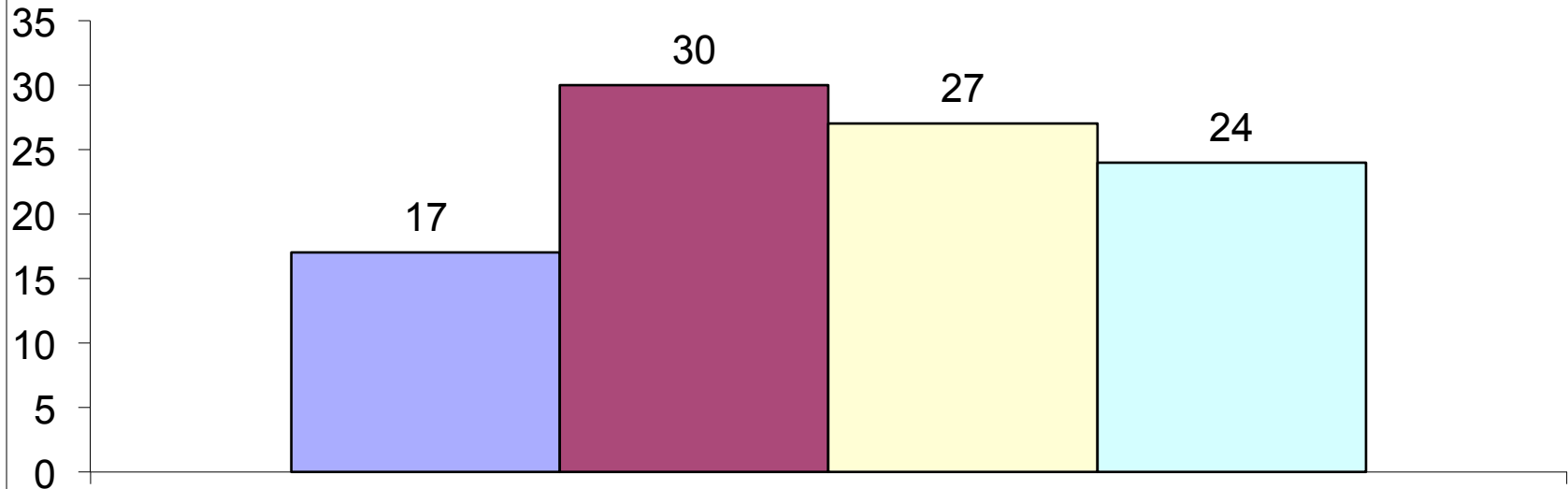
Number of Tattoos



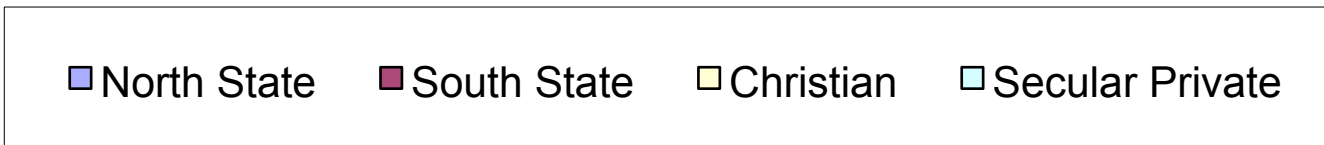
Comparative Percentages



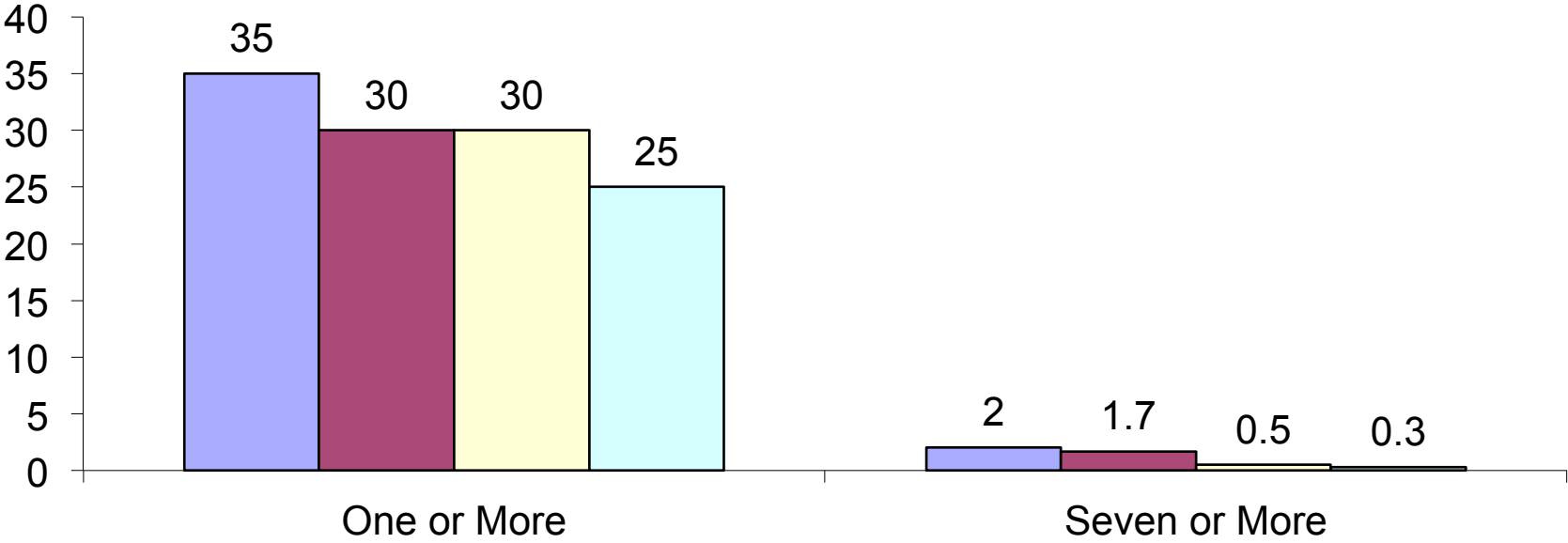
Tattooed Respondents With Religious Tattoo



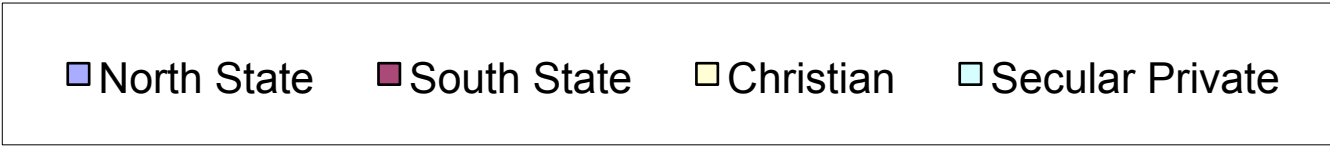

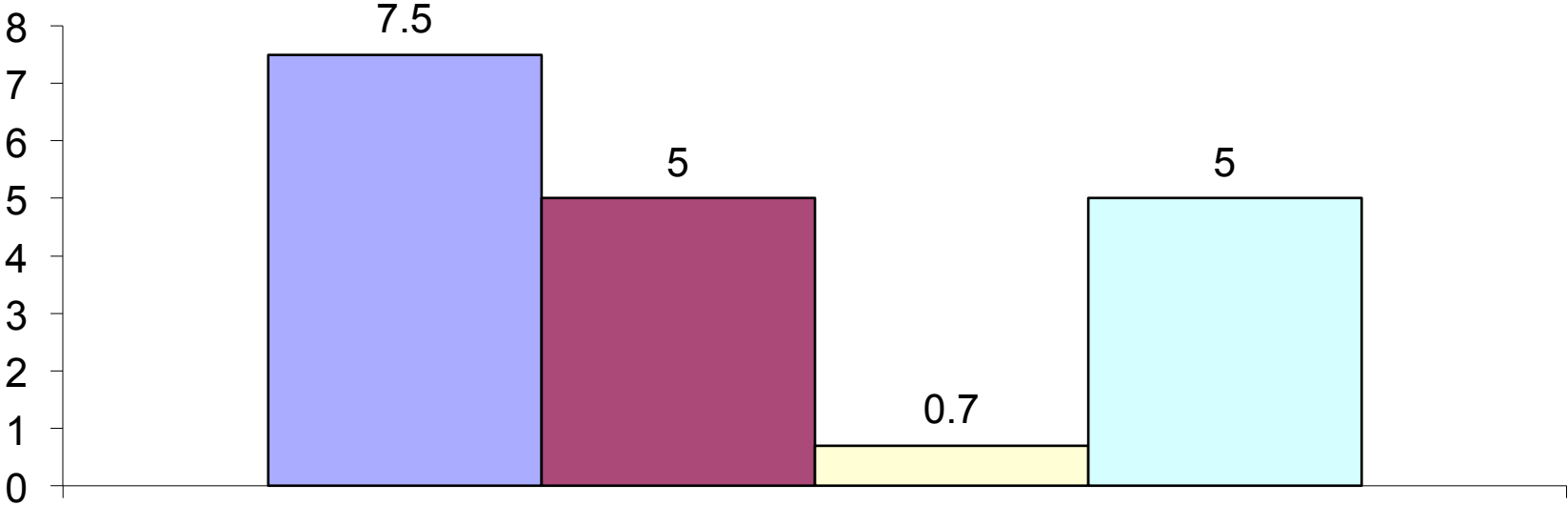
Number of Piercings
